

# \$196 million

In March and April alone, that's how much NCF givers mobilized to charities during the COVID-19 pandemic.

This is a 31% increase over March and April last year, with 46,403 grants sent to the organizations rising to the present challenge.

All numbers are pre-audit estimates from March and April 2020

## 3,000 grants

were sent to humanitarian aid and disaster relief, totaling \$17.1 million.



## 400% increase

NCF givers quadrupled the dollar amount sent to disaster-relief organizations.



## \$42.5 million

went to churches nationwide,

a 62% increase from the amount granted to churches at the same time last year.

^ More than \$4 million went to organizations providing food, and some NCF givers even took matters into their own hands, serving hungry people in need in their communities.
